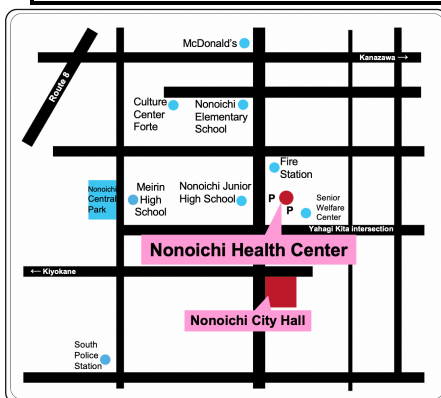
Individual notifications will be sent regarding the following vaccinations. If you moved to Nonoichi, please bring your Maternal and Child Health Handbook (if you do not have one, please bring one that shows your immunization history) to the Health Center. You will be issued a vaccination ticket. This is free of charge (limited to inoculations within the validity period indicated on the vaccination ticket).

- Women born between April 2, 1997 and April 1, 2005 who have not completed three doses of HPV the vaccine can receive the remaining doses free of charge until March 31, 2025.
- Japanese Encephalitis vaccine is available for those born between April 2, 1995 and April 1, 2007, and have not been vaccinated three times until the age of 19.
- Please consult with the Health Promotion Section if you have a disease that requires long-term medical treatment and you were not able to receive the vaccination during the eligible age period.

Support for children's vaccinations

Eligible vaccinations	Mumps, influenza, and hepatitis A. Voluntary vaccinations for children who are not of the routine immunization age.
Amount	Maximum 1,000 yen per vaccination
Frequency	Once per fiscal year
Eligible person	Residents up to the 3rd year of middle school at the time of vaccination or application submission
Application period	Within 1 year from the month following the date of vaccination
What you need to apply	Bankbook in the name of the applicant (guardian) Original receipt (Should be stamped, with the following listed: The name of the person to be vaccinated, medical institution, date, type of vaccination, and the fee amount)

Dental check-ups for expectant mothers

Periodontal disease is correlated with higher rates of premature delivery. See your doctor as soon as possible after you enter the stable period.

Eligibility : Pregnant women (limited to residents)

Location : Designated Dentists

Home visitation

A Public Health Nurse or Midwife will visit your home to check your child's height and weight, and do a care consultation.

 What to bring : Maternal and Child Health Handbook, Medical Examination Form attached to the Maternal and Child Health Checkup Voucher Booklet (乳②).

※No individual notification will be given, so please see the doctor within the above timeframe.
 ※Please make sure to make an appointment with the hospital prior to the checkup, as some hospitals may not be able to provide checkups.
